

Amalfi Coast, Naples & Capri Group Tour



Tour Description

This group tour offers a comprehensive exploration of Southern Italy, combining the timeless heritage of Rome with the vibrant energy of Naples, the coastal beauty of Sorrento and the Amalfi Coast, and the elegance of Capri.

Designed as a shared group experience, the itinerary blends guided cultural visits, authentic food-focused activities, and carefully paced leisure time. Participants travel comfortably by private bus, enjoy selected meals and experiences, and are accompanied by a dedicated tour leader throughout the journey.coast.

Tour Services

- * 8 nights accommodation in selected 4-star hotels in Rome and Sorrento.
- * Accommodation in a private room (Double/twin or Dus to be specified after the confirmation) with daily breakfast.
- * Dedicated tour leader for the entire duration of the tour.
- * Private bus and driver for all scheduled transfers and excursions.
- * Licensed local guides in Naples, Pompeii, Capri, and Reggia di Caserta.
- * Guided walking tour of Naples historic center.
- * Guided visit to Pompeii Archaeological Site.
- * Full-day excursion to Capri with round-trip ferry tickets.
- * Cheese factory visit and lemon farm experience in the Sorrento area.
- * Wine tasting and lunch at a winery near Mount Vesuvius.
- * Pizza cooking class with dinner in Naples.
- * Selected lunches and dinners as specified in the itinerary.

Detailed Itinerary

Day One – Arrival in Rome and Welcome Dinner



Participants arrive independently in Rome and check in at the 4-star hotel. Rooms are available from the afternoon, with luggage storage available for early arrivals.

In the early evening, the group meets the Tour Leader for a welcome aperitif at the hotel, followed by a group dinner at a nearby restaurant featuring traditional Roman cuisine, offering a relaxed introduction to the journey.

Day Two – Transfer to Sorrento via Naples



After breakfast at the hotel, the group departs Rome by private bus, accompanied by the tour leader and driver, heading south toward the vibrant city of Naples. Upon arrival, participants enjoy a guided walking tour through the historic center, discovering landmarks such as Piazza del Plebiscito, the Royal Palace and the San Carlo Theatre. The walk continues along Spaccanapoli, the lively artery of the old town, with an external visit to Naples Cathedral.

Lunch takes place at a local trattoria, where participants savor authentic Neapolitan cuisine, ending the meal with a traditional sfogliatella pastry or gelato. In the afternoon, the journey continues along the coast toward Sorrento.

Upon arrival, participants check in at the 4-star Hotel. Free time allows for a leisurely walk through Piazza Tasso or a visit to Marina Grande, the town's charming historic harbor. The day concludes with dinner at the hotel.

Day Three – Sorrento Food Experience and Amalfi



The day opens with a journey into the hills surrounding Sorrento for an authentic food experience. Participants reach Agriturismo Il Turuziello, where a traditional cheese-making demonstration reveals the techniques behind the production of mozzarella and caciocavallo. Fresh tastings of local cheeses and olive oil follow, offering a true taste of the region.

The experience continues at a nearby farmhouse with a guided lemon tour, where participants discover the history and cultivation of Sorrento's iconic citrus groves. Lunch is served on site, featuring regional dishes such as lemon risotto and other local specialties, paired with local wines or beverages.

In the afternoon, the group travels by private bus toward Amalfi. Upon arrival, free time is available to wander through the town's picturesque streets, admire the exterior of Amalfi Cathedral, or relax at a café overlooking the sea. In the late afternoon, the group returns to Sorrento. Dinner is at leisure.

Day Four – Pompeii and Winery Lunch



After breakfast at the hotel, participants travel by private bus to Pompeii, where a licensed private guide leads a visit through the remarkably preserved archaeological site. The tour offers insight into daily life in ancient Roman times and the dramatic eruption of Mount Vesuvius that froze the city in history.

Following the visit, the journey continues to a winery located at the foot of Mount Vesuvius. Here, participants enjoy a cellar visit, a guided wine tasting and lunch, featuring local specialties and wines grown in volcanic soil. In the afternoon, the group returns to Sorrento, with the evening free and dinner at leisure.

Day Five – Capri Day Tour



In the morning, participants travel to the port of Sorrento and board a ferry bound for Capri. Upon arrival, a guided exploration introduces the island's most iconic sights, including the lively Piazzetta and panoramic viewpoints overlooking the sea. Lunch is at leisure.

The afternoon is free to enjoy Capri at one's own pace, whether strolling through elegant streets, browsing local boutiques, or relaxing by the water. Later in the day, the group returns to Sorrento by ferry. Dinner is served at the hotel.

Day Six – Leisure Morning and Pizza Class



After breakfast, the morning is free for participants to enjoy Sorrento independently. Lunch is not included. In the afternoon, the group travels by private bus to Naples for a hands-on culinary experience.

Guided by a professional pizzaiolo, participants learn the art of traditional Neapolitan pizza-making, from preparing the dough to baking their creations. The experience concludes with dinner, enjoying the freshly made pizzas together. In the evening, the group returns to Sorrento.

Day Seven – Vietri sul Mare and Positano



After breakfast, the group departs Sorrento for a scenic drive along the Amalfi Coast, arriving in Vietri sul Mare, celebrated for its centuries-old ceramic tradition. Participants explore the historic center and visit local artisan workshops showcasing colorful handcrafted pieces. Lunch is served in town, featuring regional coastal cuisine.

In the afternoon, the journey continues to Positano, where participants enjoy free time to explore its vertical streets, browse local boutiques and visit the Spiaggia Grande area. In the late afternoon, the group returns to Sorrento. Dinner is served at the hotel.

Day Eight – Reggia di Caserta and Return to Rome



After breakfast and check-out from the hotel, participants travel north toward Rome, stopping for a guided visit to the Reggia di Caserta. The tour explores the magnificent royal apartments of this 18th-century palace, renowned for its grandeur and elegant interiors. Lunch is served near the palace before continuing the journey to Rome. Upon arrival, participants check in at their 4-star hotel and gather for a final group dinner at a nearby restaurant, bringing the journey to a close.

Terms and Cancellation policies

Art. 1 terms and regulations:

- Group capacity: min 14 pax – max 28 people per group
- If the group tour does not reach the minimum capacity of participants by 3 months (90 days) prior the start of the tour, it will be cancelled.
- In case of the cancellation by the Great Italy Tour, the Great Italy Tour will return the amount paid by the customer via nexi payment platform.

Art. 2 – cancellation policy on behalf of the client:

Once customers pay the amount of a day tour, in the case of the eventual withdrawal on behalf of the client for any reason before departure, the client will be charged the following percentage of the participating shares, calculated taking into consideration how many days before departure he/she has requested the cancellation. From the day following the booking until:

- * 60 days pre-departure: 30% penalty : in this case Great Italy Tour will refund the 70% of the full amount paid.
- * 59-30 days pre-departure: 50% penalty : in this case Great Italy Tour will refund the 50% of the full amount paid.
- * 29-0 days pre-departure 100% penalty.
- By confirming the reservation and making the payment, you accept the regulation and the itinerary as previously described.

Art. 3 – Tour variations

The service providers (hotels, agritourisms, restaurants, chefs, etc.) At times mentioned in our tour itineraries are subject to change. In this unlikely event they will only be substituted by others of equal or better quality in order to avoid affecting the content of our services.
