

Pietrasanta, Bocelli's Alpemare & Forte dei Marmi Shorex



Tour Description

This shore excursion from Livorno explores Tuscany's elegant seaside lifestyle, combining art, coastal towns, and refined gastronomy. The itinerary includes a guided walk in Pietrasanta, lunch with Bocelli wine pairing at the exclusive Alpemare Beach Club, and free time in Forte dei Marmi, offering a relaxed experience along the Tyrrhenian coast before returning to port.

Tour Services

- * Pick-up and drop-off directly at Livorno Port.
- * Air-conditioned bus dedicated to the group for all transfers.
- * Professional English-speaking Tour Leader for the entire excursion.
- * Visit of Pietrasanta with the Tour Leader.
- * Four-course lunch at Alpemare Restaurant with Bocelli wine pairing.
- * Free time in Pietrasanta and Forte dei Marmi.

Detailed Itinerary

Morning – Livorno Port and Pietrasanta



Participants meet the professional Tour Leader at Livorno Port and depart by private bus toward the Tuscan coast. The scenic drive leads to Pietrasanta, a refined art town known for its marble heritage and vibrant cultural life (approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes drive).

Upon arrival, the Tour Leader leads a walking tour through the historic center. The visit introduces elegant streets and squares, art galleries, marble workshops, and landmarks such as Piazza del Duomo and the Cathedral of San Martino, reflecting the town's long standing artistic tradition (approximately 1 hour).

After the walk, participants enjoy free time to explore Pietrasanta independently, browse boutiques or galleries, or relax with a coffee in one of the local cafe's (approximately 1 hour).

Midday – Alpemare Beach Club



The excursion continues with a short transfer to Bocelli's Alpemare Beach Club (approximately 15 minutes drive).

Lunch is served at Alpemare Restaurant, featuring a four-course menu paired with Bocelli wines. The experience is enjoyed in an elegant seaside setting overlooking the Tyrrhenian Sea (approximately 2 hours).

Afternoon – Forte dei Marmi and Return



After lunch, participants enjoy free time in Forte dei Marmi, one of Tuscany's most stylish beach resorts. This interval allows for strolling along elegant streets, browsing exclusive boutiques, relaxing at a seaside cafe', or walking along the promenade and pier with views of the Tyrrhenian Sea and the Apuan Alps (approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes).

In the afternoon, participants rejoin the Tour Leader and depart for the return journey to Livorno Port, arriving comfortably and in good time to rejoin the ship (approximately 1 hour drive).

Terms and Cancellation policies

Art. 1 terms and regulations:

- Group capacity: min 25 pax – max 48 people per group
- If the group tour does not reach the minimum capacity of participants by 5 days prior the start of the tour, it will be cancelled.
- In case of the cancellation by the great Italy tour, the great Italy tour will return the amount paid by the customer via nexi payment platform.

Art. 2 – cancellation policy on behalf of the client:

- Once customers pay the amount of a day tour, in the case of the eventual withdrawal on behalf of the client for any reason before departure, the client will be charged the following percentage of the participating shares, calculated taking into consideration how many days before departure he/she has requested the cancellation. From the day following the booking until:
 - * 6 days pre-departure 0% (free cxl till 5 days prior the tour)
 - * 5-0 days pre-departure 100%.
- By confirming the reservation and making the payment, you accept the regulation and the itinerary as previously described.

Art. 3 – tour variations

The service providers (hotels, agritourisms, restaurants, chefs, etc.) At times mentioned in our tour itineraries are subject to change. In this unlikely event they will only be substituted by others of equal or better quality in order to avoid affecting the content of our services.
